

**Loyola University Chicago Stritch School of Medicine
Assistant/Associate Professor of Bioethics**

The Neiswanger Institute for Bioethics & Health Policy is seeking an assistant or associate professor of bioethics. The position is tenure track within the Loyola University Chicago Stritch School of Medicine. The successful candidate will possess a doctorate or the equivalent in philosophy, theology, health-care ethics, the social sciences, or public health. The candidate's areas of specialization and competence are open but the institute has particular needs in the areas of the responsible conduct of research and Catholic moral thought. The position includes teaching responsibilities in the medical school curriculum and in a vibrant graduate program. Experience providing clinical ethics consultations is a plus. This faculty member will join an expanding multi-disciplinary faculty that includes scholars from health care, law, philosophy, theology, and the social sciences.

Based in the western suburbs of Chicago, Loyola University Health System is a quaternary care system with a 61-acre main medical center campus and 22 primary and specialty care facilities in Cook, Will and DuPage counties. The medical center campus is conveniently located in Maywood, 13 miles west of the Chicago Loop and 8 miles east of Oak Brook, Ill. The Loyola University Chicago Stritch School of Medicine has research institutes in bioethics and health policy, burn/shock/trauma, cardiovascular, neuroscience, oncology, and signal transduction. More than 500 medical students and 500 residents are taught by more than 1,200 full-and part-time salaried faculty.
